## WORKSHOP 1: MEASURING CLIMATE POLICY PERFORMANCE – DIFFERENT INDICATORS AND APPROACHES

Why do we need to measure climate policy performance, and why must caution be exercised when it comes to interpreting the findings of different metrics? In this workshop, hear from Dr Kammerer on the different definitions of climate policy performance, and the various indicators and platforms available, such as the Climate Change Performance Index, the Climate Policy Harmonization Index, or the Climate Action Tracker. Participants will get the opportunity to compare the assessments of different indicators for a case country.

## WORKSHOP 3: MAPPING NDC AMBITION WITH NATIONAL CLIMATE TARGETS

The goal of the Paris Agreement to keep global warming preferably below 1.5°C can only be reached if countries commit to and adopt ambitious climate mitigation action plans. While many countries are increasing the ambition of their climate targets, it is not yet clear whether they will be able to keep up with those promises. This event looks at how countries translate their international climate commitments to domestic policies? Hear from Dr Kammerer on a new index being developed to measure the degree of harmonization between climate mitigation policies at the domestic level with the targets pledged in the Paris Agreement. Detailed results for selected case studies, including Singapore, will be presented.
