Platform: WhatsApp (with an active mobile service/ personal WiFi hotspot)

Till: 31 Dec 2024, 9am to 6pm daily

Duration of trail: About 2 hours (with two “in-game” rest stops)

Best played with: Family and friends, ages 5 and up

If you feel like doing more to keep the vicinity clean while playing the game, you can bring along tools such as tongs and trash bags to pick up litter along the way!
