### SYNOPSIS

Efforts to mitigate and adapt to climate change must persist, even amidst the complexities and challenges of global geopolitics. Now more than ever, investors must play a pivotal role in addressing climate change effectively and equitably for all stakeholders involved. Climate investments on a massive scale are needed and while the E in ESG investing movement has received much attention and backing, the investing community is going through its own journey. In this presentation, Munib will share his view on how investors are not the first to have gone through a realisation of their responsibility towards the environment.
