Half the world faces high water stress for at least a month each year – with water stress expected to worsen with climate change and rising demand. This growing scarcity threatens water-dependent businesses, with agriculture using about 70% of water withdrawals, and industry driving consumption and pollution. Water stewardship must be a core part of every company's sustainability to ensure long-term resilience.

To explore this urgent issue, the Centre for Governance and Sustainability (CGS) at NUS Business School and Kering are hosting a workshop, **Water Matters: Making Ripples in Corporate Sustainability**, to advance the business case for water stewardship and share insights from CGS' study on Corporate Water Stewardship: Strategies and Practices in Asia-Pacific.
